VITICULTURE

Traditional. Many of the vineyards in polyculture vineyard / olive tree. Bush vines. Manual harvest.

ELABORATION AND AGING

Pressed in oil presses with esparto mats.

SOILS

Very steep vineyards facing south and west, located at around 550 meters asl. Shallow, stony and fine textured soils developed from Paleozoic schists.

VINTAGE CHARACTERISTICS

In the Axarquía region of Malaga, 2016 in general was a late and dry year. The delay of the vegetative cycle was generated by abundant rainfall in May, which also favored a strong pressure of mildew, resulting in the loss of part of the crop.

It was a good vintage for dry wine since at harvest the grapes came in very fresh and there were very few raisins in the bunches.
